Anti-Corruption Commission Files Charges

Following a complex and protracted investigation, investigators from the Anti-Corruption Commission have on 13th August 2024 charged the following persons:

Douglas Anthony SMITH, aged 48 years, of North Sound Estates, Grand Cayman, and

Shaun Michael Abshire **SCOTT**, aged 24 years, of George Town, Grand Cayman are charged with the following offences:

- 1. **CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT FRAUD ON THE GOVERNMENT**, contrary to sections 11(1)(a) and 52 of the Anti-Corruption Act (2019 Revision),
- 2. **OBTAINING PROPERTY BY DECEPTION,** contrary to Section 247(1) of the Penal Code (2020 Revision),
- 3. **BEING CONCERNED IN A MONEY LAUNDERING ARRANGEMENT,** contrary to section 134 (1) of the Proceeds of Crime Act (2020 Revision).

Both persons will appear at Court at 10:00am on Tuesday, 27th August 2024. No further information will be released, at this time.
